<i>Administrative / Biographical History:</i>	<p>In April 1977 the Ministry of Defence notified Western Isles Islands Council (WIIC – now named Comhairle nan Eilean Siar) of its proposals to upgrade and develop Stornoway Airport to enable it to be used in a national emergency. The proposals included the extension of the runway, the construction of a fuel discharge point in Broad Bay, the construction of an undersea/ underground pipeline from the oil discharge point to tanks at the airfield and the construction of four new fuel tanks at two locations within the airfield perimeter. Initially, the WIIC had decided not to object in principle to the proposals, but on 29 June 1978 the Council decided to rescind its previous decision and oppose them and notified the MOD by a letter dated 13 July 1978. Further proposals for the development of Stornoway Airport were submitted by the MOD to the Council in December 1979 and on 22 May 1980 the WIIC notified the MOD that they also opposed the Stage 2 proposals.</p> <p>Local opposition to the proposals began as soon the detail of the proposed changes, and the full implications of them, became known. Starting with the community councils of Sandwick and Loch a Tuath (Broad Bay), opposition grew through the support of the local branches of the Labour Party and the SNP, the local MP Donald Stewart, representatives of the Free Church of Scotland, the Trades Council, An Comunn Gaidhealach and the local authority (WIIC).</p> <p>A mass public protest meeting was called by the Western Isles Constituency Labour Party on 20 October 1979, which was held in the Seaforth Hotel, Stornoway. The protest group, which was apolitical, was then formally convened and held its inaugural meeting on Thursday 15 November 1979 in the Nicolson Institute. At the inaugural meeting the group was known as the Stornoway Airport Extension Action Group. Angus McCormack was elected Chairman. Other office bearers were William Macleod (Vice Chairman), Murdo Macleod (Interim Secretary) and Jennifer Macdonald (Treasurer). Donald J. MacSween was appointed Gaelic Spokesman.</p> <p>The Action Group agreed at its inaugural meeting to oppose, open to them, the extension of Ministry of Defence and NATO Activity at Stornoway Airport. The Group also agreed to apply for financial assistance to the WIIC, the Stornoway Trust and the Lewis Development Fund, to start a general fund-raising</p>

campaign and to approach the local church presbyteries to seek their support.

It was also reported at the inaugural meeting that Thule Press had offered to publish a joint booklet with the Anti-Nuclear Group (later known as HAND: Hebrides Against Nuclear Dumping). HAND had been formed in response to concerns about the Western Isles becoming a dumping ground for nuclear waste. The joint booklet was to be published under the title 'Islands at Risk'. It was agreed at a subsequent meeting to approach Angus Macleod ('Scotsman' journalist), Murdo Macfarlane, Brian Wilson, Angus McCormack and the Rev. D. Gillies for contributions to the booklet.

At the second formal meeting of the Stornoway Airport Extension Action Group, held on 10 December 1979, it was agreed that the Group would be known as KNO (Keep NATO Out) with the sub-heading 'Campaign to oppose NATO escalation at Stornoway Airport.' Artist Calum Maclean was to be approached about producing a logo. It was reported that the Scottish Episcopal and Roman Catholic Churches had rejected the Group's requests for support. The Church of Scotland adopted a neutral stance, although may have shifted its position by September 1980. At the KNO meeting of January 1980 it was reported that the Western Isles Free Church Presbytery not only supported the group but had formed their own sub-committees.

The minutes of January 1980 also refer to a letter from HAND indicating they would 'keep the KNO Committee informed of any activities being undertaken by them, in order that events and press releases would not clash.'

Arguments put forward against the MOD proposal were that it would likely lead to the destruction of a unique way of life of a close-knit island and rural community. As knowledge developed of the consequences of the establishment of the base and the reasons for it, KNO later broadened its scope to oppose the escalation of the arms race, and particularly the nuclear arms race, in which Stornoway's new base would play a large part.

As a result of a highly effective publicity campaign, support for KNO came from similar campaign organisations across the UK, Europe and the USA. It attracted support from the Scottish Trades Union Congress (STUC), the Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament (CND), Scottish CND, END (European Nuclear Disarmament), student political groups, and various other Peace and Disarmament Groups.

KNO publicity materials and activities included posters, badges, car stickers, handbills, cartoons, press statements, articles in a range of publications, letters to the press, radio and television interviews, publications such as the 'Islands at Risk' booklet, car cavalcades, marches, public meetings, ceilidhs and bonfires. A Peace Vigil was held on 24 October 1981 for UN Day. Several of the activities involved both KNO and HAND.

Campaigners such as E.P. Thompson of END travelled to Stornoway to join the protests. A separate youth peace

movement - SITH (Gaelic for 'peace') – was formed and engaged in similar activities. The KNO minutes of 6 March 1981 report that it was agreed 'to encourage as many pupils as possible to attend a demonstration at the opening of the Public Inquiry at 12.30 on 16th March 1981.' A joint trip of KNO and SITH to Paris was also organised. There is a reference in the minutes of 7 October 1981 to two members of 'SITH' being co-opted onto the committee of KNO. KNO established a close link with WIIC and helped support it against pressure from the MOD.

A petition of 4,200 signatures was presented to the Secretary of State for Scotland at the Scottish Office in Edinburgh. 2000 individual objections were sent to the Scottish Secretary, and 52 local objections were placed before the WIIC.

In January 1982 discussion took place as to whether the KNO campaign should remain exclusively local or whether its remit should extend to working with national bodies like CND and END. Much of the committee voted for the latter. This led to two people leaving the committee due to a disagreement about this strategy, but they didn't cease in support of the opposition to the MOD plans for Stornoway Airport.

The activities and reach of KNO began to grow nationally and internationally. KNO did not join CND or END but had close and cordial relations with these groups through Bruce Kent (Secretary, CND) and Professor E.P. Thompson (leader, END). Both prominent peace activists visited Stornoway and played a role in the KNO campaign, as did Olafur Grimmson who became the President of Iceland where Keflavik was an American base. Similarly, Angus McCormack, Chairman of KNO, attended the national Labour Party Conference in 1982, and a conference in Iceland, where he was the principal speaker.

As the group took on a wider role, its structure became more complex. Around February 1982 there was a committee of 12 members, and an Executive Committee (Press and Publicity) of 5 members as follows:

- Calum Maclean: Trade Union liaison;
- Mavis Laing: CND, Peace, college and university liaison;
- W. J. Macdonald: WIIC and political parties liaison;
- D. Stewart: Gaelic, Culture and Church;
- J. Macdonald: Fundraising

Surviving minutes for this period are sporadic, so it is not known if this operating model was sustained.

Continued Council and KNO pressure led to the calling of a Public Planning Inquiry on 16 March 1981. The Inquiry concluded that the WIIC was justified in reaching their decision not to approve the development. This was overturned, however, by the Secretary of State for Scotland, George Younger, who gave the MOD the go-ahead for the development which, in his opinion, was 'in the national interest', despite the opposition.

	<p>As a result of Younger's decision, the KNO campaign moved to one of direct action. A blockade of the base took place on Saturday 24 September 1983. An address by Donald Stewart MP followed by songs, poetry readings, a release of balloons saying, 'No to Nuclear Stornoway' and an afternoon of videos and discussions occurred.</p> <p>KNO argued that the upgrading of Stornoway's airport was not to serve the UK national interest but rather, for Stornoway to become a nuclear transit camp for American reinforcements coming to Europe to fight Reagan's 'limited nuclear war'.</p> <p>The Stornoway Airport runway extension proceeded. Hard standings were built but never used. A fuel entry point was built on Lamb Island against the wishes of local crofters and the advice of the Maritime & Coastguard Agency who argued that the sea conditions were not suitable. It was connected by underground pipe to underground tanks close to Steinish but this infrastructure has never been used. Occasionally NATO planes are given permission by the civil authority to overfly or land at Stornoway. Not until June 1990 did the Conservative Government state that Stornoway would not become a NATO base.</p>
